Annual Notice To Parents Regarding Teacher Qualifications

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Our school receives federal funds to Title 1 programs that are a part of ESSA legislation. As part of this act, we want to provide you with this annual parent notice.

As a parent of a student at Antwerp Elementary School, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teacher(s) who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask certain information about your child's classroom teachers and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if requested. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- A. Whether the Ohio Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- B. Whether the Ohio Department of Education has decided that said teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- C. The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has an advanced degree and, if so, the subject area(s) of the degree.
- D. Whether any paraprofessionals provide services to your child, and, if they do, their qualifications.
